The Dushinske & Jamison Water Resources Scholarship Endowment was established by the North Dakota Water Education Foundation (NDWEF) within the North Dakota Community Foundation in memory of Russ Dushinske and Warren Jamison and their distinguished service, dedicated leadership and life-long devotion to water development in North Dakota.

### SCHOLARSHIPS

Income from the Dushinske & Jamison Water Resources Scholarship Endowment provides scholarships to two deserving North Dakota students whose families have taken an active role in state water resource management. Two \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded each year to one female and one male. Scholarship recipients must attend a North Dakota college or university and preference will be given to, but is not limited to, students studying water-related fields. **Scholarship recipients are required to attend the Annual North Dakota Water Convention Awards Banquet on Dec. 3, 2009 to read the winning essays.**

### APPLICATION PROCESS

Applications for the Dushinske & Jamison Water Resources Scholarship must be submitted to the NDWEF no later than April 1. The NDWEF will notify the scholarship recipients by May 1. **The scholarship awards will be presented at the Awards Banquet of the North Dakota Water Convention on Dec. 3, 2009. Recipients must attend the banquet to receive their scholarships.**
